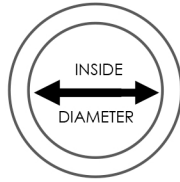
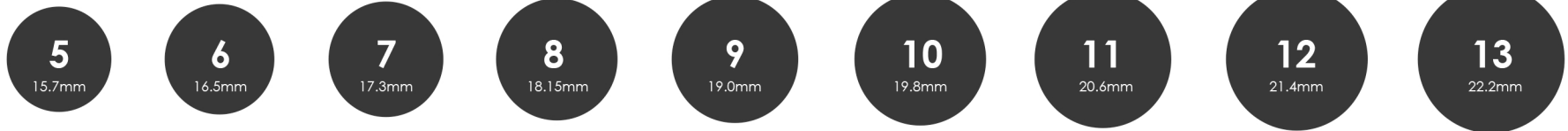


MEASURING A CURRENT RING

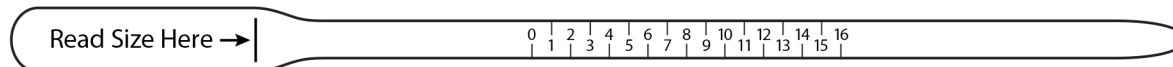
1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
3. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.

1. Cut out the Ring Sizer shown below. Cut a small slit next to the arrow.
2. Place the Ring Sizer around your finger, then slip the pointed end through slit with the numbers facing out.
3. Tighten the Ring Sizer by pulling the pointed end toward your finger. The fit should be snug but comfortable.
4. Simply read the number pointed to by the arrow next to "Read Size Here".
